

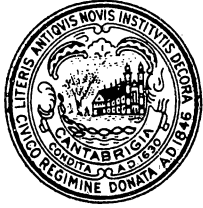

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is a request to appropriate \$8,000 to the Department of Human Service Programs Other Ordinary Maintenance account. This appropriation will finance the Senior Cab Program for the rest of the fiscal year. The program provides Cambridge residents over 65 with a 25% discount on the meter rates charged by taxis through the use of prepaid tickets.

The program, which is financed by the sale of the discount tickets, was previously administered through a special trust and agency account. An appropriation into the general fund would allow for increased fiscal controls, facilitate the bill-paying process and utilize the TAG system to monitor the program's activity.

Passage of this order is recommended.
