IN CITY COUNCIL

January 12, 1987

- WHEREAS: In spite of belated interim attempts to alleviate the unfortunate plight of the Cambridge homeless, as yet no long term remedy has been advanced; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to take all appropriate steps to provide a section of land at Fresh Pond near the Neville Manor site for the purpose of constructing a 12,000 - 15,000 square foot building with 100 beds to shelter the Cambridge homeless; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to consult with Shelter, Inc. of Cambridge and also with Caspar on this project in regard to management and also to provide for making the building a turn key project; and be it also
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to (a) set up a special Committee of businessmen to solicit donations from the business community; and (b) send out a general letter to citizens of Cambridge asking them to donate to the foregoing project.
