- Subject Matter: 1.) To reduce payments for the months of May, June, and July of 1981 payable from producers as the Commission deems equitable and to amend 331 C,R 6.01 (1) (a) and 6.01 (1) (b) to take effect at 12:01 A.M., May 1, 1981, for the purpose of accomplishing said reduction.
- 2.) The Class II price per hundredweight of milk in state regulated market areas shall be the same price as the price announced from time to time by the Federal Market Administrator pursuant to Federal Milk Order No. 1. Amendment: 331 CMR 8:04 (3) (b)
- 3.) The butterweight differential in state regulated market areas shall be the same as that set by the Federal Market Administrator pursuant to Federal Milk Order No. 1. Amendment: 331 CMR 8:08 (5) (a - z)
