The Committee on Public Property which was instructed to consider the expediency of adopting an Order for the grading of Hastings Square on Brookline Street, and to report the probable expense, has considered the subject and would respectfully

Report:-

That, by the terms of the deed from Mr. Hastings, it would seem that the City ought to grade said Square.

Brookline Street might with advantage be cut down about one foot, near the Square, and there would then be sufficient material for grading the Square.-

The whole expense it is estimated would not exceed \$150.00 - and, in view of the sum realized by cutting gravel from the Square for the use of the City - the Committee would recommend the adoption of the Order -
