UNFINISHED BUSINESS

3. The proposed amendment to the General Ordinances in Chapter 2, Article XXIII, Section 2-191 providing for an increase in the Salary of the Director of Veterans Services and Benefits - the question comes on passing to be ordained on or after September 29, 1975.
4. The proposed amendment to the General Ordinances providing for the installation of protective partitions in taxi cabs in the City of Cambridge - the question comes on passing to be ordained on or after December 8, 1975.

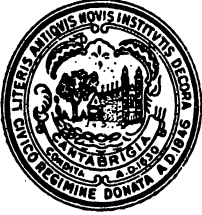

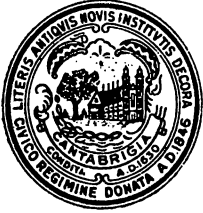



I am, therefore, including the proposed amendment to the Ordinances providing for a change in penalty.

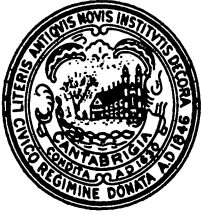



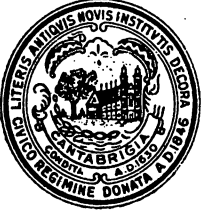
