Gentlemen:-

The Board of Park Commissioners at a meeting held last evening considered the petition, referred by you on the 13th inst., of F.W. Pondergast for establishment of a children's playground in Ward 5.

The Board voted, after visiting the site, that while they realize the need of a playground in the Ward, the one pointed out by the petitioner is not suitable and accordingly no public hearing will be necessary.

The Board also wishes to report that permission has been obtained from the Water Board to plant the abandoned water trough in Brattle Street at Craigie Street and work of placing loam and planting flowers will be done very soon. This matter was referred under vote of your board April 14th, 1922.
