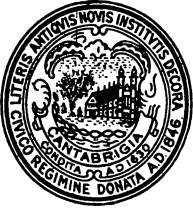

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$77.11 to reimburse Richard Woods, employee of the Public Works Department, for damages in this amount.

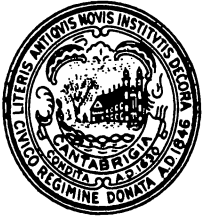
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Richard Woods, in which there was a judgment of \$77.11.


