The Public Works, Traffic and Parking and Police Departments met today to formulate plans for its snow removal operations for the coming winter. They are asking all parkers in the City to cooperate with them by obeying all the laws pertaining to snow emergencies and snow removal operations.

If, there is a threat of snow or it is snowing, listen to your radio or watch television for notification of a snow emergency being declared in the City of Cambridge:

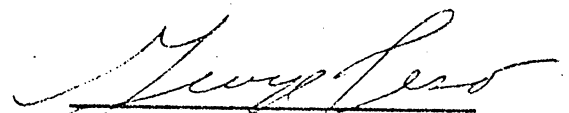
If a snow emergency is declared make sure your motor vehicle is not parked in any area posted with signs stating "NO PARKING DURING DECLARED SNOW EMERGENCY".

All violations will be tagged and towed and the towing charge during a snow emergency is \$25.00. Add a \$2.00 storage cost and the \$15.00 parking ticket to the towing fee and it could cost a violator as much as \$42.00 for not moving their motor vehicle.

If at any time there are any questions concerning a snow emergency, call the Traffic and Parking Department at 876-6800, Ext. 314 and someone will be there to assist you.

The City of Cambridge does not like to tow or ticket during these snow emergencies but the illegally parked cars do create a serious problem for our emergency vehicles as well as our snow plowing and snow removal operations.
