

In Board of Alderman Dec. 7th 1870

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that Cambridge Street from the junction of Bridge to First Street, be widened on the southerly side thereof, by taking for this ~~purpose~~, certain parcels of land as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer and now before this Board,

Therefore, Ordered, That so much of the land on either ^{south} side of Cambridge St. from the junction of Bridge to First St. belonging to the persons hereinafter named as is included between the red lines shown on a plan of Cambridge Street drawn by J. G. Chase City Engineer dated and now before this Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said Cambridge Street.

Ordered, That damages for the land so taken, be estimated and awarded as follows:
