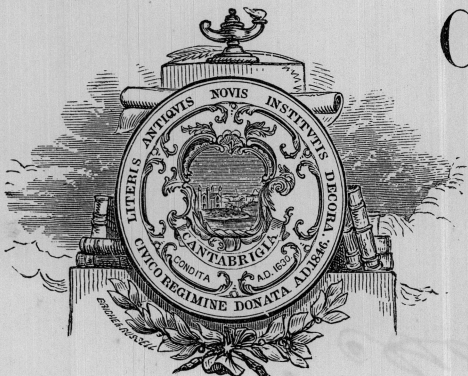




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

July 16, 1873.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Putnam Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *Forty feet* in width between

Roadway and Cambridge Street

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *C. H. Bowker*

Dated May 6, 1873

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and* *that 30 days be allowed for removal of fences or other obstructions standing on the land so taken as aforesaid.*
