To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$103,000.00 from the General Fund Police Salary & Wages Account to the Police Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$10,000) and Extraordinary Expenditures Account (\$93,000). The funds will be used for the purchase of a new booking/prisoner taping/monitoring system. The proposed system would allow for the complete taping of the booking process. This would be accomplished with the addition of a second camera in the booking room and a special split-screen video taping system which would record both cameras.

New video recording devices would be purchased. Additional cameras would be placed in the holding area and in the hallway facing the women's cell area. The current cameras, as well as all monitors, would be replaced with new state-of-the-art cameras and monitors. Funds also will be used to purchase 4 unmarked vehicles with 4 existing vehicles traded in.
