WHEREAS: In 1948, the Daughters of Mary of the Immaculate Conception began their sponsorship of Sancta Maria Hospital, then a 65-bed hospital on Memorial Drive offering a range of medical and surgical services; and

WHEREAS: Because several of the physicians had ties to the Red Sox organization, Sancta Maria soon became the hospital of choice for injured Red Sox players and became known as the “Red Sox hospital;” and

WHEREAS: In the late 1960’s, the hospital relocated to the Fresh Pond area, and a new, six story building opened in 1968 with a 150-bed capacity; and

WHEREAS: In 1989 Sancta Maria became the first acute care hospital in the state to convert to a long-term care facility; and

WHEREAS: Today Sancta Maria’s Campus houses 141 long-and short-term care residents, diagnostic services and on-site physical therapy and dialysis services, along with a new child care center and a brand-new adult day care program; now therefore be it

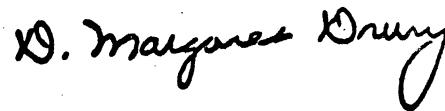
