I am supporting the neighbors' efforts for a pedestrian light on Huron Avenue and Chilton/Gurney streets. As you know, that intersection has heavy pedestrian traffic and many drivers treat Huron Avenue as a speedway.

I would also suggest that the Council initiate a major initiative to enforce pedestrian crosswalk laws and speed limits all over the city. A concerted police effort to enforce these laws might make all of us drive and walk more safely. In other places, drivers stop when someone takes a step off the curb. And perhaps drivers cutting through Cambridge streets would not find those shortcuts so attractive.
