- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the Elderly Assistance Program within the Human Services Department is about to initiate an outreach program aimed at identifying vacancies within rent controlled and/or Section 8 housing units for our elderly residents; and
- WHEREAS: Affordable housing units for all Cambridge residents should be a top priority for this government; as it should be throughout the country for all people; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Rent Control Board to encourage landlords to contact the Elderly Assistance Program when and if vacancies become available, and to further emphasize to the landlords the benefits for those who participate in the Section 8 program.
