In Board of Aldermen, Sept. 15. 1886

Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges of this board, be authorized and directed to cause the setting of Edge stones, as follows:-

On Putnam Avenue, westerly side, from Mount Auburn street to a point opposite the westerly end of Green street, about 275 feet more or less.

On Putnam Avenue, easterly side from Green street, northerly, for a distance of 92 feet, more or less.

The work of the foregoing to be done under the direction of the Superintendent of Streets, and the expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, (Paving.) The cost of materials furnished to be assessed upon the owners of abutting lands, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 191 of the acts of the year 1863.
