WHEREAS: The License Commission has informed the City Council that it will hold hearings on December 8 to determine whether licensed establishments which request it may extend the hours of their license on New Year's Eve; and

WHEREAS: This issue surfaced last New Year's eve when residents in several parts of the city were seriously disturbed by carousing customers of local establishments;

ORDERED: That the City Manager communicate with the Executive Director of the License Commission to let him know the concern of the City Council that extensions of license privileges be granted only where it is almost certain to have no impact on the quiet and serenity of nearby residents.
