To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 99-12, regarding a report on steps to compensate property owners who may have incurred damage to their buildings and water systems and equipment due to the reconstruction of Cambridge Street, please be advised of the following:

Steps for property owners who may have incurred damage to property during the sewer separation construction on Cambridge Street include:

- Property owner should submit a written claim or description of damage to the property to the Contractor. In order to facilitate property owners' claims, the Public Works Department will do one of the following:
- Public Works will supply the property owner with the name, address, telephone number, and point of contact of the contractor for direct contact; or
- Public Works will forward the information to the Contractor on the project for filing with the Contractor's Insurance Carrier for investigation and processing.
