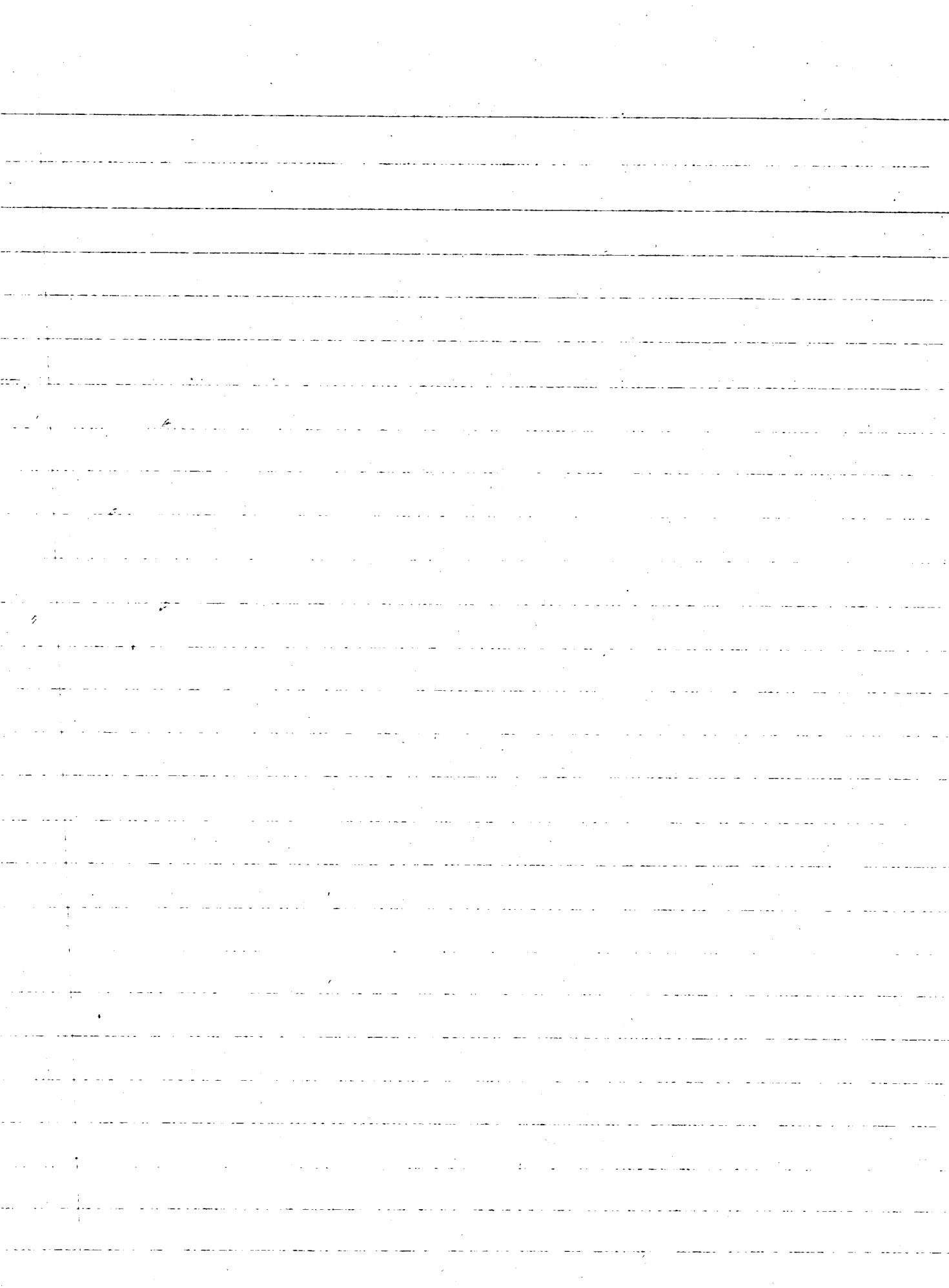


We the undersigned, Selectmen of the Town
of Watertown hereby signify and consent to the grad-
ing of Coolidge Avenue from the dividing line between
Cambridge and Watertown to the gate of the Cambridge
 Cemetery. Said grading to be done by and at the
expense of the City of Cambridge, deeming hereby only
to give consent to the said works being done within
the limits of said Town of Watertown. provided al-
ways that the City of Cambridge shall assume all
liability for the damages done to any person or con-
struction by any change of the grades of said Cool-
idge Avenue and shall hold the said Town of
Watertown, and us, the undersigned, forever harm-
less and indemnified from and against any and
all liability, damage and costs resulting therefrom.
