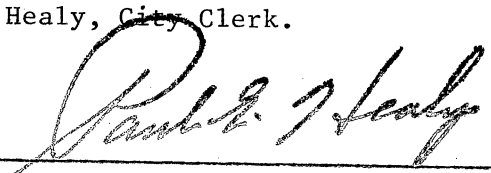

- ORDERED: That if the Chief of Police feels that this cannot be done, if he cannot assign an officer to be on duty during the hours of the ban, he should explain why he can not, and what he will do to correct the situation, (i.e., will he request this in his next budget, will he try to transfer an officer from another detail, etc.); and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Chief of Police be requested to report back to the City Manager within two weeks of the date of this order.
