ORDERED:-

Upon the petition of Frank Ferdinand Inc., that the Superintendent of Streets be authorized, under the provisions of Section 33, Chapter 25 of the Revised Ordinances of 1892, and amendments thereto, to grant a license or permit to the petitioner to erect and maintain a marquee to be constructed of steel, glass, and copper to project over the sidewalk at 505-507 Massachusetts Avenue.

The marquee to be fifty (50) feet in length, twelve (12) feet in width and twelve (12) feet above the level of the sidewalk. The inner edge of the said marquee to be firmly attached to the main wall of said building and the other edge to be sustained by chains attached to said main wall, all as shown upon a plan filed with said petition.

The design and construction of said marquee to be under the Superintendent of Buildings and the Superintendent of Streets and to be approved by them.

Provided that the licensee, under this order shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000) Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said marquee. Said bond to be subject to the approval of the Mayor.

Provided, further, that the license shall be subject to revocation at any time by the City Council for the time being.
