The Joint Special Committee appointed to confer with E. Port Phillips and the Cambridge Mutual Fire Insurance Company, and ascertain and report what arrangements can be made towards widening Luman and Main Streets, near their estates, would respectfully

Report

That your committee has conferred with the several owners of land abutting on Luman Street, between Main and Austin Streets, and has been unable to obtain any proposition or price for the exchange or purchase of land for widening Luman Street.

Your Committee having made a thorough investigation of the plans and purpose of Mr. Phillips and the Cambridge Mutual Fire Insurance Company, in reference to the improvement of their respective estates, - recommends that Luman Street be widened on the westerly side to a uniform width, from a point about one hundred feet northerly of the northerly line of Austin Street produced, to Main Street.
