- WHEREAS: The Cambridge City Council, by adopting a comprehensive ban against smoking in public places, recently recognized the serious health danger that passive tobacco smoke poses; and
- WHEREAS: A similar recognition prompted the U.S. House of Representatives to pass the Durbin amendment, banning smoking on all domestic airline flights of two hours or less; and
- WHEREAS: This legislation will soon come before the U.S. Senate, where its fate is uncertain; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council urge the United States Senate to support legislation banning smoking on domestic airline flights; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk transmit copies of this resolution to Senator Kennedy and Senator Kerry on behalf of the City Council.
