To the Honorable, the City Council:

In accordance with the provisions of Ordinance 733, I am submitting for your consideration the proposed lease of the property at 5 Bigelow Street to the Cambridge YWCA. The terms of the lease will stipulate that the house will be used to provide short-term housing to five displaced Cambridge families as well as three young adults in transition. A description of the housing plan is attached. The one-year lease, which will be for a nominal amount, will contain provisions for maintenance and upkeep with the cost to be borne by the lessee, will provide for a capital repair and improvement fund, and will stipulate that a house committee be established which would include representation from the neighborhood.

The public need for transitional housing has been demonstrated time and again and certainly justifies the terms of the proposed agreement. Without this consideration the proposed program could not take place. In an effort to provide for occupancy at the earliest date possible, I strongly urge that the City Council refer this recommendation to the Planning Board for a report and that the City Council schedule a public hearing, pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance 733, on October 26th.

DRAFT Housing Plan for Five Bigelow Street

The Department of Human Services in conjunction with the Young Women's Christian Association, Travelers Aid Society and Cambridge Family and Children's Services, all non-profit community based organizations, proposes to create and support at Five Bigelow Street, housing for displaced Cambridge families and young adults. On the first two floors, five apartments would be for families who are housing-ready and are waiting for permanent housing in Cambridge. The sixth apartment would be occupied by the resident building manager. The third floor at Five Bigelow would be used as a supervised apartment for three young adults, ages 17-20

Young Women's Christian Association is an organization committed to improving the lives of women and families by providing them with services and support at a low cost. The YWCA addresses issues of housing, daycare, health promotion and fitness; and offers a century-old presence in Central Square, with a strong social advocacy tradition and an active local membership.

The City, through the Department of Human Services, would lease the building to the YWCA. As the lead agency in the project, the YWCA will design and manage the family housing program (floors 1 and 2), hire, supervise, and coordinate general operations. The YWCA will coordinate all building upkeep and maintenance and be responsible for the day-to-day management of the house.

Travelers Aid Society of Boston has as its mission "...to provide counseling, protective services and information to people in transition...who are in need of assistance or adjustment to the community"...

Travelers Aid will provide professional social workers, working out of the city's Multi-Service Center - 15 Pearl Street, to screen, assess and refer families to Five Bigelow. Travelers Aid's staff will also provide on-going case management services, including counseling and housing search to the families and be in regular contact with the resident manager (YWCA).

Cambridge Family and Children's Service offers to the residents of greater Cambridge a wide range of treatment, rehabilitation and prevention programs. CFCS is a non-sectarian social service organization whose goal is to promote, enrich and support sound individual and family development.

CFCS will supervise on a 24-hour basis a three bedroom apartment on the third floor for young adults. A coordinator will supervise and live at the apartment full-time, occupying one of the bedrooms. (A relief Coordinator will be available, when necessary, to substitute for the full time coordinator.) Three young adults will live in the apartment sharing the two bed rooms. This apartment will be one component of the agency's Teens in Transition Resource Center, a United Way funded program, which provides information and assistance to young adults to establish ways to live independently.

In addition the **Cambridge Housing Authority** will be a partner in this effort by providing housing subsidies through its 707 program.

The strength of this collaborative effort is its ability to aid displaced Cambridge residents by providing them with long term stay, near their families, friends and resources, in order for them to regain secure and permanent housing in our community.

Dear Councillors:

We, the undersigned and all being residents and property owners of Bigelow Street, wish to express our concerns to you regarding the purchase by the City of Cambridge of the referenced Properties on our Street and the announced plans for the use of said buildings.

1. It is our understanding that the Maryknoll Building will be used to house additional City departments. Regarding the use of the building for additional City employees, we have observed that there is very little parking available on the site at present. In a building of this size (approximately 12,600 square feet exclusive of basement), one might expect 83 employees to occupy the building at 150 square feet per employee with perhaps 50% of these driving to work. We believe that the addition of 42 more cars per day looking for parking spaces on Bigelow and the streets surrounding City Hall will exacerbate an already frustrating condition for the residents of the area. We would encourage the City to make specific provisions for additional parking in full compliance with the existing zoning code for the site which requires a minimum of 1 car per 1,000 square feet

of building area under Section 6.363(f) of the Zoning Ordinance. If these spaces cannot be made available on-site, we suggest that the City make specific provisions for reserving spaces for these employees in the surface parking lots on Green Street.

2. Regarding the use of #5 Bigelow Street for transient housing, it is a stated City policy to distribute public housing evenly throughout the City. Recent studies have shown that Mid-Cambridge and in particular, the area around Central Square, is already meeting its proportional obligations with respect to public housing. Additionally, although quasi-public and receiving support from the United Way, our neighborhood also houses the YMCA and YWCA which supply transient housing for a substantial number of people. There is also a shelter at the corner of Lee and Harvard Streets. Earlier this year, the City began work on a family housing site on Inman Street. We applaud the efforts of the City in attempting to provide for the special housing needs of City residents. We would however encourage the City Concillors to stand by their pledge to distribute this housing evenly throughout all neighborhoods. It is our recommendation that #5 Bigelow Street be converted for use by permanent residents, not for use as transient housing.

The YWCA will coordinate all building upkeep and maintenance and be responsible for the day-to-day management of the house.

Travelers Aid Society of Boston has as its mission ... "to provide counseling, protective services and information to people in transition...who are in need of assistance or adjustment to the community"...

Travelers Aid will provide professional social workers, working out of the city's Multi-Service Center - 15 Pearl Street, to screen, assess and refer families to Five Bigelow. Travelers Aid's staff will also provide on-going case management services, including counseling and housing search to the families and be in regular contact with the resident manager (YWCA).

Cambridge Family and Children's Service offers to the residents of greater Cambridge a wide range of treatment, rehabilitation and prevention programs. CFCS is a non-sectarian social service organization whose goal is to promote, enrich and support sound individual and family development.

CFCS will supervise on a 24-hour basis a three bedroom apartment on the third floor for young adults. A coordinator will supervise and live at the apartment full-time, occupying one of the bedrooms. (A relief Coordinator will be available, when necessary, to substitute for the full time coordinator.) Three young adults will live in the apartment sharing the two bed rooms. This apartment will be one component of the agency's Teens in Transition Resource Center, a United Way funded program, which provides information and assistance to young adults to establish ways to live independently.

In addition the **Cambridge Housing Authority** will be a partner in this effort by providing housing subsidies through its 707 program.

The strength of this collaborative effort is its ability to aid displaced Cambridge residents by providing them with long term stay, near their families, friends and resources, in order for them to regain secure and permanent housing in our community.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In accordance with the provisions of Ordinance 733, I am submitting for your consideration the proposed lease of the property at 5 Bigelow Street to the Cambridge YWCA. The terms of the lease will stipulate that the house will be used to provide short-term housing to five displaced Cambridge families as well as three young adults in transition. A description of the housing plan is attached. The one-year lease, which will be for a nominal amount, will contain provisions for maintenance and upkeep with the cost to be borne by the lessee, will provide for a capital repair and improvement fund, and will stipulate that a house committee be established which would include representation from the neighborhood.

The public need for transitional housing has been demonstrated time and again and certainly justifies the terms of the proposed agreement. Without this consideration the proposed program could not take place. In an effort to provide for occupancy at the earliest date possible, I strongly urge that the City Council refer this recommendation to the Planning Board for a report and that the City Council schedule a public hearing, pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance 733, on October 26th.
