I am also thankful and appreciative for the resolution recognizing the Guleserian family.

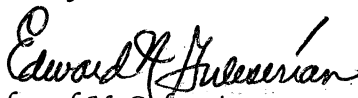
The event would not have taken place without the guidance of Sandy Albano. Please commend this true professional for her immeasurable help assisting with the planning and implementing of this honor.
