WORLD WIDE COMMUNICATIONS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

World Wide Communications Limited Partnership, organized in the State of Nevada, has applied to the Department for authority to provide resold telecommunications services within the Commonwealth. World Wide would provide resold long distance service to residential and business customers. Since the Company does not have its own network and does not operate or control any switching equipment, customers would presubscribe to the Company's designated underlying carrier.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of World Wide Communications Limited Partnership, under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

World Wide has filed a schedule of its proposed rates and charges for the provision of resold telecommunications service within the Commonwealth. World Wide's rates would cover only the intrastate network usage. The Company's proposed tariff has been suspended until July 17, 1991.

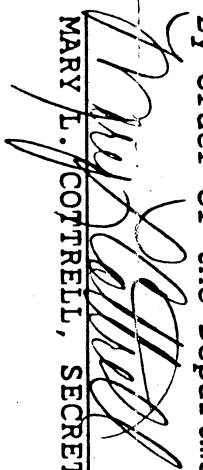
The above investigation is officially captioned:

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in the following tariff: M.D.P.U. No. 1, Table of Contents; Original Pages 1 through 23, inclusive, filed with the Department on December 17, 1990, to become effective January 17, 1991, by World Wide Communications Limited Partnership.

The Department has consolidated its investigations into World Wide's application and proposed rates and charges. A public hearing regarding the above investigations will be held on Wednesday, April 17, 1991 at 10:00a.m. at the Department's Hearing Room 1210, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts.

The Petitioner, World Wide Communications Limited Partnership, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once, at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield), the Springfield Union News (Springfield) and the Worcester Telegram (Worcester), and to serve a copy at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date on the parties on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
