ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Director of Traffic & Parking and the Police Chief to take the necessary steps to place stanchions/barrels (painted orange) in the middle of cross-walks at dangerous intersections throughout the city at which no traffic signal is present to assure that pedestrians will be able to exercise their right of way and that motorists will yield to exercise of that right. Further, that affixed to the stanchion/barrel will be the notation, citing appropriately the section of the Massachusetts General Law which mandates this obligation; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the Council on this matter by April 1, 1991
