

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Sept- 2nd 1871

Whereas it is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Gardner Street so called from Prospect Street to Tremont Street be laid out as a public highway,

Ordered, That said Gardner Street be and hereby is laid out and established as a public way, by the name of Gardner Street, agreeably to a plan drawn by The City Engineer bearing date of September 23^d 1871 and now before this Board, to wit from Prospect Street to Tremont Street. the same to be thirty feet in width as shown by the red lines delineated on said plan. Ordered, That damages for the land so taken and for the removal of the fences be estimated and awarded as follows.

Estate of Oliver Hastings 6 feet of land 50¢ \$3.00

" " " removal 4 1/2 ft of fence 20¢ 8.00 \$11.00

" " Mrs H C Park 21 feet of land 50¢ 10.50

" " " removal 37 feet of fence 740 17.90
\$28.90

Ordered, That thirty days be allowed to the persons over whose land said Street is laid out, for the removal of their fences.
