This investigation is officially captioned:

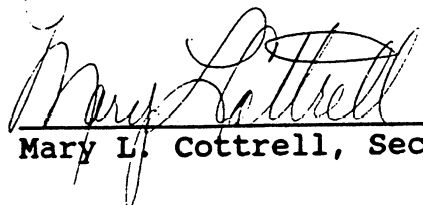
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Application of RealCom Office Communications, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added, or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before June 28, 1993.

The petitioner, RealCom Office Communications, Inc., is required to give notice by publication hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [July 6, 1993], on the Other Common Carriers on the attached Interexchange Carriers list, and to make return of service and publication no later than July 12, 1993.
