

## THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY TO  
SELL AND CONVEY TO THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court  
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. In consideration of such sum as an independent, qualified appraiser shall determine to be the value of the parcel of land and the building thereon, the county commissioners of Middlesex county, in the name and on behalf of said county, are hereby authorized to sell and convey to the city of Cambridge a certain parcel of land located on Third street in said city, formerly known and used as the third district court of eastern Middlesex. Said land shall be used for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2. Any monies received from the city of Cambridge for the purchase of said land and building shall be distributed by the county treasurer of said county to the cities and towns of said county in accordance with the provisions of chapter six hundred and sixty of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
