AN ACT AUTHORIZING STEVEN GIACOPPO TO TAKE THE CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT

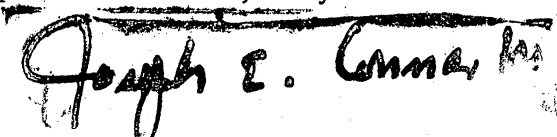
