In Board of Aldermen, Apr 19 1882

Ordered, That the Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges on the part of this board be and hereby is authorized and instructed to cause brick sidewalks to be laid in the street hereinafter named, to wit:

On Linnaean street, on the northerly side, extending from North Avenue to Avon Hill street, also on the southerly side extending from Bowdoin street to Avon street

On Avon street, on the easterly side from Shepard to Linnaean street, also on the westerly side from line of Ch. Fawcett to Shepard street,

On Mellen street, on both sides thereof from North Avenue to Oxford street,

The expense of such sidewalks to be assessed upon owners of abutting estates according to law.
