Dear Mr. Corcoran:

At a meeting of our organization on January 15, 1974, held at the Corporal Russell E. Hoyt Post Headquarters, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS:

It has been a long-established policy of the City of Cambridge to fully compensate superior performance and recognize added responsibility by its employees

AND WHEREAS:

The office of the Director of Veterans Services has expanded and its functions moved far beyond its original conception

AND WHEREAS:

The many changes in the procedures in the Veterans Affairs in State and Federal level and the new Social Security Implementation Program effective January 1, 1974, which might be beneficial to the elderly, blind, and disabled

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That Pasquale L. Reale, the present Senior Department Head be appointed Administrative Director of the Veterans Benefits and Services Departments and that a just and fair compensation for the above mentioned additional responsibilities be established.

It should be pointed out that our organization, representing all veterans groups, encompasses well over 50% of the people of the City -- parents, children and other dependents.

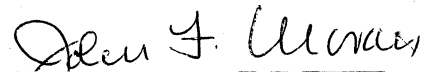
We are hopeful that the new administration will be far more responsible to the needs of the veterans and their families and dependents and more cooperative in joint civic and charitable endeavors.
