To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$120,000.00 in the grant fund from the Cambridge Housing Authority to the Human Services Salary & Wages Account \$57,178.00, Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$61,022.00 and Travel & Training Account \$1,800.00. The grant is a renewal of an existing contract between the Cambridge Housing Authority and Human Services. Project SETTLE determines whether homeless families can be moved successfully to permanent housing within 12 months if transitional services are made available to meet their needs and at less cost than hotel, motel or shelter placements. The City is providing care management and support services to all families in the program. The contracted goal is that 20 families will be successfully served over a 12 month period.
