Report of Committee.

June 19th. 67.

The committee of surveyors of Highways to whom the petition of Abram W Watson and others, was referred, asking to have the grade of Spring Street, with the side walk established, and the edge stone reset would respectfully report that they have examined and carefully measured said Street, between third and fourth. and find it seriously encumbered. On the south side by a fence. standing in the street nearly two feet from the line. On the north, by stepping stones, so placed, as to endanger the limbs, if not the life of pedestrians. Your committee believe that the prayer of the petitioners should not be granted, so long as the above mentioned encroachments continue.
