RESOLVED: That the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and Meacham Road be designated as Kevin A. Griffin Square, and a ceremony to mark this occasion be held in June of 1995 when the Griffin family will be assembled in Cambridge to celebrate the Ordination of Paul Griffin to the Priesthood.
