

# City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Dec. 14, 1871.

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that Winsor Street should be widened on its North westerly side, near the corner of Broadway, by taking certain land belonging to Margaret Fanning:-

Therefore Ordered, That a strip of land on the North westerly side of Winsor Street, near the corner of Broadway, belonging to Margaret Fanning containing seventy-four square feet, being so much of her said land as lies South Easterly of the North westerly line of Winsor Street, as delineated on a plan drawn by J. L. Chase, City Engineer, dated Nov. 1, 1870, and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public way and a part of said Winsor Street.

Ordered, That the sum of \$2,034 be paid to ~~her~~ Margaret Fanning for the land taken as aforesaid, and as damages for moving her building standing at the corner of Broadway and Winsor Street.
