- WHEREAS: The US Army Natick Research Design and Engineering Center (NSRDEC) of Natick, Massachusetts is an institution set up to research survivability, sustainability, mobility, combat effectiveness and quality of life of the Soldier; and
- WHEREAS: NSRDEC researches cutting edge solar panel and "thin film" technologies for use in tent material through it's Shelters Technology, Engineering, and Fabrication Directorate (STefd); and
- WHEREAS: The Special Projects team and the NSRDEC Operational Forces Interface Group (OFIG) support local projects and events through their outreach personnel; and
- WHEREAS: On October 18-19, 2008, the NSRDEC STefd and OFIG teams supported the SolarWirelessMile initiative by loaning and setting up a solar "temper fly" and balance of electrical systems at Corporal Burns Park to demonstrate the power and ease of use of renewable energy systems and their value as energy generators for a free wireless internet system; now therefore be it
