In Board of Aldermen, Sept 14th 1864

The joint Committee on Roads & Bridges to whom was referred the petition, of William Page and others, "that the grade of Main Street near Hancock Street may be lowered" have considered the same and respectfully report.

They find that the Street in front of Mr Page's residence is about 14 inches higher than the sidewalk, & that the Street on each side of the Railroad is very sideling; so much so that it is actually dangerous to travel.

They also find that it would be impossible to raise the sidewalks, in front of the Estates on the West side, without doing great injustice to the owners. The Committee are of the opinion that the Street should be lowered, but as the whole matter properly belongs to the Board of Surveyors of Highways, would recommend that the subject be referred to them.
