

# City of Cambridge.

In the year One thousand, eight hundred and seventy three.

An Ordinance in relation to expenditures by Committees of the City Council, or either Branch thereof.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:—

Section One. No Committee of the City Council, or of either Branch thereof, shall make expenditures or contract debts on behalf of the City, <sup>to a sum exceeding fifty dollars</sup> unless expressly authorized so to do by vote of the City Council; and no authority to purchase supplies or materials, or to make contracts of any kind, shall be construed to include the travelling or other expenses of any Committee. Such expenses, when necessarily incurred, shall be ~~for~~ provided for by special Order of the City Council, and unless so provided for, shall be disallowed; and payment thereof refused.
