WHEREAS:

An out-of-State tour bus (chartered by affiliates of Tufts) was parked overnight (Saturday) March 17 and blocked parking for parishoners of First Church Congregational, Garden and Mason Streets, (Sunday) March 18; and

WHEREAS:

Arrangements for the Tufts bus to load and unload student residents of the Sheraton-Commander in front of First Church Congregational have been designed to accommodate the Sheraton-Commander without regard for the persons and activities of First Church Congregational which is in use 7 days a week, day and night; now therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager is requested to have the Traffic Department find another "Bus Stop" for Tufts students and "ticket and tow" commercial tour vehicles using the parking space appropriately used by parishoners of First Church Congregational at Sunday Worship.
