PETITION : We, the undersigned, being residents of Cambridge, do petition the City of Cambridge to enforce all applicable health, building, fire and safety codes as related to the residential property at 49 Bristol Street in Cambridge, Massachusetts. The property is in deplorable condition, there is debris of long standing in the yard, generating rat infestation, any person or persons living in the building are at risk of life and limb because of the conditions of the building, there is a wood burning stove, which represents a further fire hazard to residents of the building and the adjoining properties, in use in the building, and it is our recollection that one person perished in the fire in the property some time ago, and little or nothing has been done since that time to correct these deplorable conditions. We present this petition both for the welfare and safety of anyone living in 49 Bristol Street, and people living in the vicinity near the property. We would appreciate immediate and continuing action by the City of Cambridge to correct all code conditions in the building to eliminate this hazard to our neighborhood.
