The lighting at Hoyt Field is on during the spring and summer for the baseball season, and then turned off for the remainder of the year. The operation of these lights is determined by the recreation department.

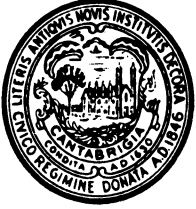
When the season is over, calls are received from abutters wanting the lights to remain on, and from abutters wanting them off.
