ORDERED:

That the City Manager instruct the Chief of Fire to report on what is contained in trucks marked with a dangerous cargo insignia and what each insignia means. If trucks carrying hazardous waste, toxic chemicals and similarly life threatening substances used on Cambridge streets, the Fire Chief should explain what precautions are taken when trucks carrying such substances pass through the City; whether he is notified that such cargo is being brought into Cambridge; and what training and preparation has taken place to cope with an accident involving such dangerous cargo; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the Chief of Fire be instructed to report back to the City Manager if there are any evacuation plans in effect and if his staff is aware of these plans, what warning would be given to residents in the area of an accident; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the Chief of Fire be instructed to describe in writing to the City Manager what his department would do in a "worst case" situation and to describe what action his department is prepared to take in the case of an oil or gas truck accident as well, including evacuation plans, warning to residents, and so on.
