OCTOBER 19, 1987

- WHEREAS: North Cambridge Senior Center and other groups who deal with our elderly citizens are endeavoring to supply our seniors with all types of services and from the point of view of simply joining with one another on a social basis; and
- WHEREAS: Many seniors live in areas which would require them to make more than one bus change to reach the services offered; and
- WHEREAS: Using public transportation might be difficult for those who are blind or disabled; and
- WHEREAS: The Council on Aging has in its possession a small bus which could be utilized more fully to pickup seniors on a regular basis at regular bus stops; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the Assistant City Manager for Human Service Programs to confer with the Director of the Council on Aging, the Director of the North Cambridge Senior Center, Community School Co-ordinators, and any other providers of services to our elderly population to work out a schedule whereby this bus can be used to its fullest extent to provide transportation for our seniors who might otherwise not avail themselves of the services offered to them.
