- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of John M. Hurley, a late native Cantabrigian and nationally recognized photographer; and
- WHEREAS: Having attended local schools, he later entered the newspaper business in 1927 as a Reporter for the Boston Post, where he worked until the paper closed its doors in 1956, and shortly thereafter joined the Boston Globe; and
- WHEREAS: While at the Globe, John served as a Photojournalist, and won several awards covering sports, news and feature stories and was the first Boston Photographer whose work appeared in the Encyclopedia Brittanica and was the recipient of the Walter Brown Trophy awarded by the Boston Press Photographers Association for best sports photograph; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Alice C. Hurley and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Hurley on behalf of the entire City Council.
