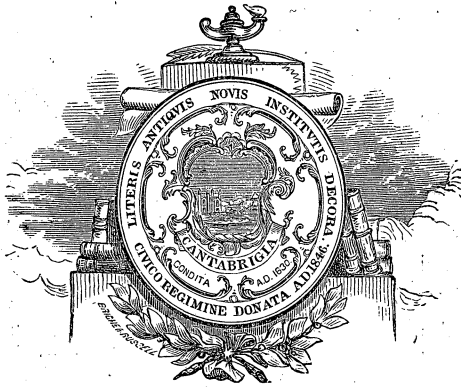


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, Sept. 18. 1866

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that *the sidewalks at the corners of Washington and Columbia Streets, Harvard and Columbia Streets, and Winsor and Harvard Street s,* should be *completed by setting proper corners and return stones,* it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to *the abutters and any other persons interested*

that this Board intends to *improve* ~~make the~~ *the* Street before mentioned, by taking a ~~portion of~~ *land and laying out the same as a public street* — and that ~~Wednesday~~ the *ten* day of ~~October next~~ *October next*, at $9\frac{1}{2}$ o'clock, P.
