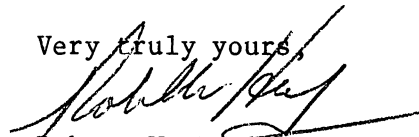

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant fund for \$30,000.00 from H.U.D. Fair Housing Assistance to the Human Rights Commission Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$21,000.00 and Travel and Training Account \$9,000.00, to provide funds for the enforcement of Title VIII and the Human Rights Ordinance with regard to Fair Housing in the City of Cambridge.
