In Board of Aldermen, *March 4.* 1896.

The *Joint* Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges
to which was referred the petition of O. C. Shepherd
and others praying that the name of Plympton Street, may
be changed to that of Charles River Street; also a remonstrance
from William H. Niles and others against such change.

Reports

Recommending that the petitioners
have leave to withdraw. Your committee further recommends
the adoption of the accompanying order changing the name of
Charles River Street, and the new street between Charles River Street
and Plympton Street, - to that of Plympton Street, so that the
latter street will extend, continuously to Dixie Street. It is
also recommended that the street be renumbered to conform to
the change of name.
