~~Ordered,~~ The undersigned a member of the Standing Committee ^{on Roads & Bridges} on the part of this board, herein signifies his dissent from the conclusion of the report of said Committee in matter of the petition of F. C. Shepherd and others, praying that the board will rescind an order passed May 17. 1882 to lay a brick sidewalk on the easterly side of Jay street.

The undersigned believes that the public necessity does not demand the laying of such a sidewalk on said street, and that it would be a great hardship upon the abutters as stated in their petition. He therefore recommends that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that so much of the order of May 17. 1882, as relates to the easterly side of Jay street, - be rescinded.
