WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is committed to energy conservation, improving air quality, and decreasing traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS: Citizens are becoming aware of the increased fragility of our planet and their responsibility in actively preserving it; and

WHEREAS: People recognize and understand that transportation options such as walking, bicycling, sharing a ride, and taking public transit to work can be conscious and thoughtful decisions made to safeguard our environment; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge Commuter Mobility Program, in collaboration with CARAVAN for Commuters, Inc. has agreed to designate "World Class Commuting Days" during Transportation Week, May 13-17, 1991 as a region-wide educational event; and

WHEREAS: Cambridge Center, Kendall Square, a Boston Properties project, is hosting the second annual Cambridge celebration of this event on May 15, 1991 to promote its continuing Transportation Services Program; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council proclaims Wednesday, May 15, 1991 "World Class Commuting Day" in Cambridge and urges the full support of all residents of Cambridge to consider alternatives to the single occupant vehicle as a method of preserving the healthy environment of our community and, by extension, our planet; and further be it

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Commuter Mobility Program for designating "World Class Commuting Days" during Transportation Week.
